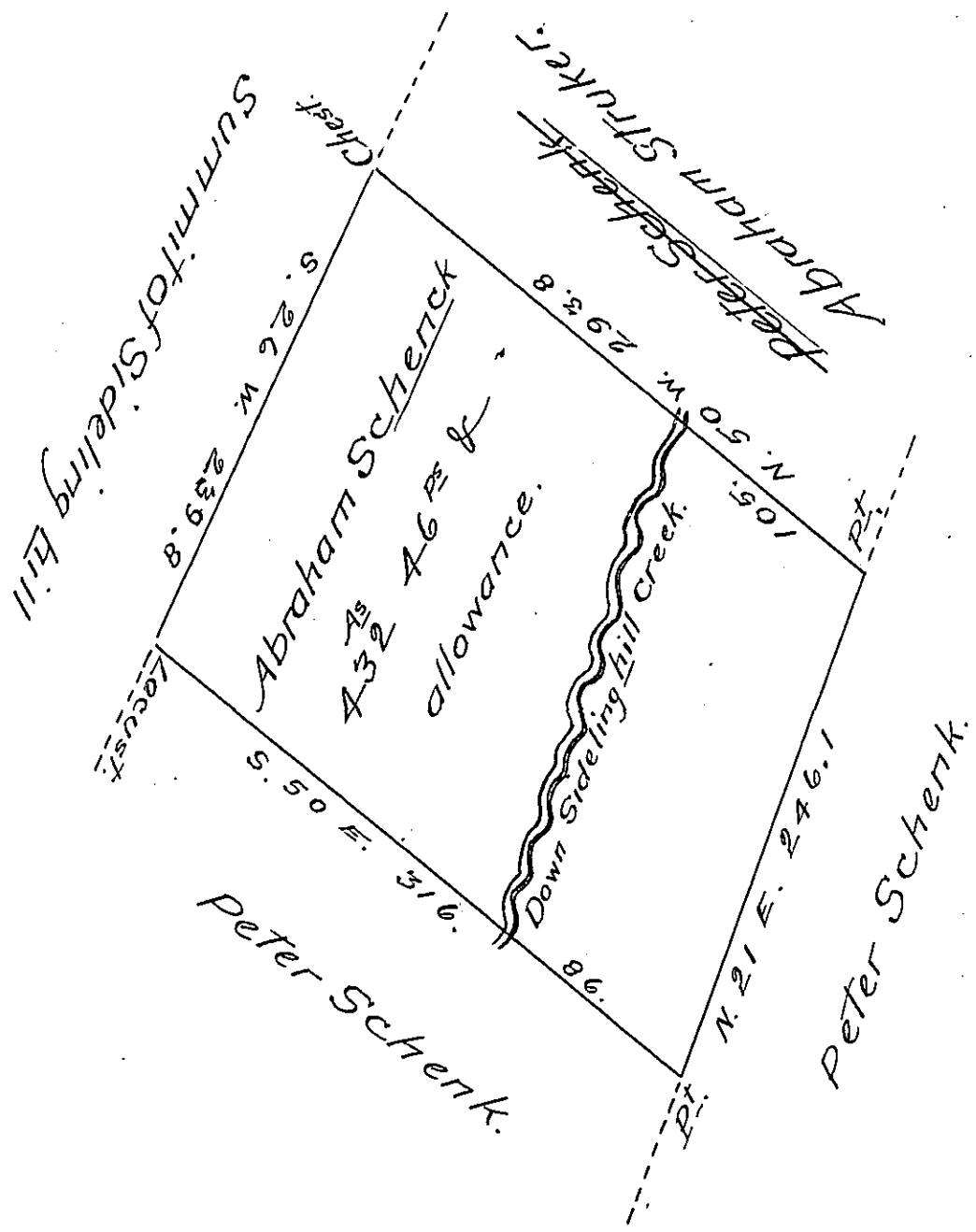

Situate on Sideling Hill Creek on the East side of Sideling Hill Mountain about two Miles South from Juniata River in Union Township Huntingdon County Containing four hundred and thirty Two acres 46-perches & allowance of six per Cent for Roads &c first Surveyed in the fall of 1794 & Resurveyed the agreeable to the old Lines found on the ground the 16th day of March 1830. In pursuance of a Warrant Granted to Abraham Schenk Dated the 1st of Sept. 1794 Examined & approved Sept 1st 1830.
