



Situate in the Township of Hopewell and County of Huntingdon on the South side of Juniata River about a mile and a half below the Town of Huntingdon. Containing Three hundred and fifty nine acres & sixty nine perches & the usual allowance for Roads.

Surveyed the 10th Day of September 1794. In pursuance of a Warrant dated the 17th day of July 1794.
