In pursuance of a warrant granted to Daniel Teague for 73 acres, dated the 19th day of March A. D. 1827, surveyed August 1st 1827, by Daniel Africa, then Deputy Surveyor, whose field notes I have examined, found correct and approved, this 7th day of June, A. D. 1856. (Interest from 1st May 1792.)
