



The Draught of a tract of Land Situate in Ferguson Township Centre County Containing thirty two Acres, Seventy Six perches and allowance of six per Cent Surveyed the 13<sup>th</sup> day of April 1813 in pursuance of a warrant granted to James Watson, dated the 3<sup>rd</sup> day of December 1812.

The improvement on the above described premises consists of a Cabbin House and about three quarters of an Acre of Cleared land, first improved in the month of April 1810, and at the time of making the Survey James Watson and family resided on the said premises.
