



A Draught of a tract of land situate in Wyalusing Township Bradford County adjoining land surveyed to Christopher Gasselman Containing thirty five acres and sixty eight perches with allowance of six per cent for roads Originally surveyed the 2<sup>d</sup> day of October 1775 to Isaac Mathers by Charles Stewart late Deputy Surveyor as appears by his Draught in my possession. In pursuance of a warrant dated the 27<sup>th</sup> day of June 1774 The tract originally Contained 302<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> with allowance but as appears on the face of the Diagram 267<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> perches and allowance is included within the Township of Springfield one of the 17 Township formerly of Luzerne County and is Claimed & Occupied by William Crawford In trust for the heirs of Benj<sup>n</sup> Crawford Deceased Examined on the Ground the 15<sup>th</sup> day of February 1819 and Certified by
