



The draft of a tract of land situate in Turbet Township in Northumberland County Adjoining lands of George McKay James Murray & others Containing forty one acres & seventy eight perches & the usual Allowance Surveyed on the 20th day of November 1812 unto James Murray by virtue of his Warrant bearing date the 11 day of August 1812.

N.B. on this survey there is a small cabbin in which a family were Residing when I made the survey there are about $\frac{3}{4}$ of an acre of land Cleared where the house stands, this Cabbin was put up in April last as I am Inform'd. a warrant has been Executed in the name of Jane Brady on the 23^d. Day of May 1811 the Survey of which covers all the land in the above survey Except that part west of the Dotted line. the Return of which survey is Inclosed. Murray Claims by an Improvement prior to the Issuing of the warrant in the name of Jane Brady which is Dated 22 March 1794
Thos. Woodside.
