Day of April last Surveyed and laid of three hundred acres & one hundred and forty nine perches of Land together with the usual allowance agreeable to the above Draught Situated in the forks of Fishing Creek in Northumberland County adjoining Lands of Simon Spalding and Solomon Perkins - Given under my hand this 4th. Day of May 1784.
