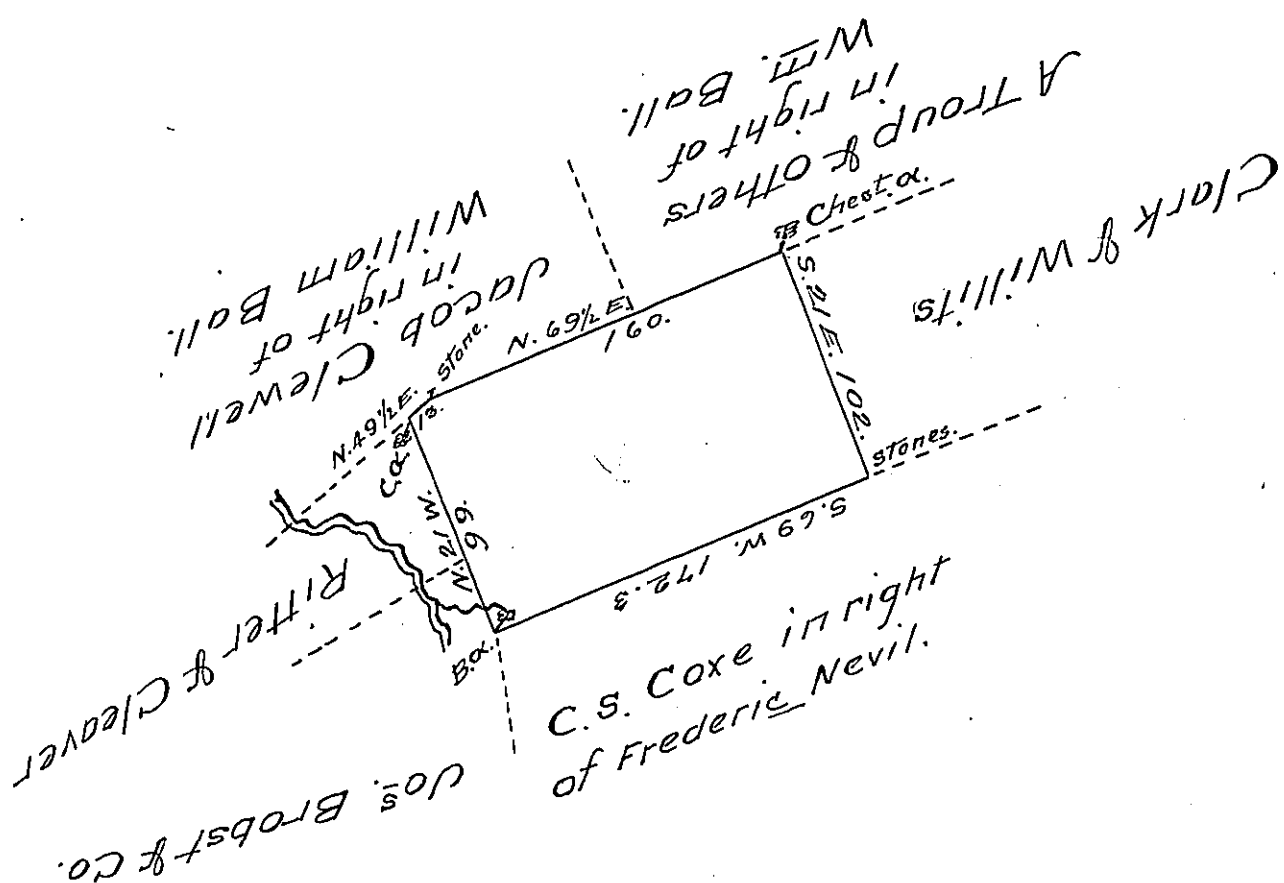


FORM NO 1.



Draught of a tract of land situate on the waters of Cattawissa creek in Cattawissa Township (formerly Northumberland 170W) Columbia County, containing one hundred and four acres thirty five perches and allowance of 6 per Cent for Roads &c surveyed unto Alexander Miller and Barn^t. Hagerman, at the request of Stacy Margerum, the 9th day of May A.D. 1835, by virtue of their warrant bearing date the 25th day of May A.D. 1792.

From the fact that the Black oak corner, upon blocking, appears to have been marked in 1792 I am induced to believe that the above survey was then made or partly made, but finding no draught in the office, from which to return, I have at the request of Stacy Margerum (the present owner) laid the warrant as above upon ground heretofore supposed to have been appropriated to this warrant and left unoccupied by more recent warrants.
