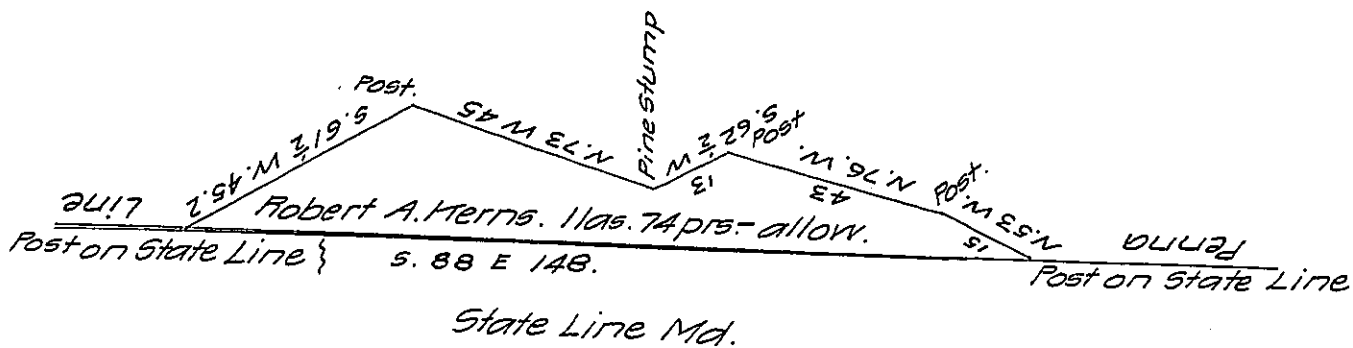


Robert A. Kerns
