



By virtue of a warrant dated March the 3d 1858 Surveyed the 3d day of May 1859 to Andrew J. Butler the above described tract of land (being improved) adjoining lands surveyed to David Ritchell, Thomas Apty and John McCahan situate on Shohola Creek in Blooming Grove Township in Pike County containing thirty three acres and the allowance of six per cent for roads &c.

Note... The above lot was first improved in A. D. 1828.
