



This is a Draught of a lott belonging to Caleb Pusey and Henry Worly  
 Scituate in the Town of Chester. Beginning at the corner of James San-  
 dilands kitchen by Chester Creek thence ~~thence~~ north 68 degrees east  
 by the land of sd Sandilands 20 perches to a stone, thence north  
 64 degrees easterly by the sd Sandilands Land 40 perch to a stone  
 by the back street of sd Town thence along sd street north 30 de-  
 grees west four perches and an half to a stone thence south 64  
 degrees west by the Church land and other Lotts of sd Town  
 sixty perches to a stone by Chester Creek thence down sd Creek  
 three perches to the Place of beginning Containing one acre and  
 ninety six perches. Resurveyed the 1<sup>th</sup> of 1<sup>th</sup> mo 1704 by virtue  
 of a Genl Warrant from the Commissioners dated 20<sup>th</sup> 3<sup>rd</sup> 1703
