Beginning at a corner marked white oak in the line of John Gibbons being also a corner of another tract of land of ye sd Pyles thence north 69 degrees westerly by the same land and another tract of the sd Gibbons's 220 Pr to a post thence S. S. W. by Vacant Land 215 perches to a chestnut thence north 83 deg easterly by Vacant Land 225 per to a sp oak thence N. E. by North 115 perches by the land of the sd John Gibbons to the Place of Beginning Containing 200 acres with allowance of 6 Pr. G. as the law directs.
