



A Draught of an Island in the River Susquehanna Manor-  
 township Lancaster County called White Flint Island, opposite  
 Martin Funk's Mill on the western bank and lying an East course  
 of about three quarters of a mile opposite the uppermost point of  
 Wisslers Island, containing Nine perches strict measure, Surveyed  
 in Pursuance of a Warrant Dated 7<sup>th</sup> day of November Anno  
 Dom. 1821, granted to George Albright and Martin Funk.
