



In pursuance of a Sale for taxes on the 13th day of February 1827 to William Gill and his conveyance dated the 23^d day of December 1834 to Alexander Erwin was surveyed on the 19th day of November 1835 for the said Alexander Erwin, the above described tract of land, situate in Cussawago township Crawford county, containing 264 acres 25 perches and allowance of Six per cent for roads &c and being the South part of the whole tract of 400 Acres Sold as aforesaid, and that part of it which lies in Crawford county, and it is also the South part of the same tract of 401 Acres 150 perches which was surveyed on the 12th day of June 1795 for Robert Lee in pursuance of his improvement bearing date the 23^d day of March 1795 as appears by Survey Book Page 51. — and at the time of the first mentioned Survey the said Alexander Erwin was in possession of and improving the said land. —

I find no Entry of any Survey on a Warrant, or any other appropriation than as above stated.
