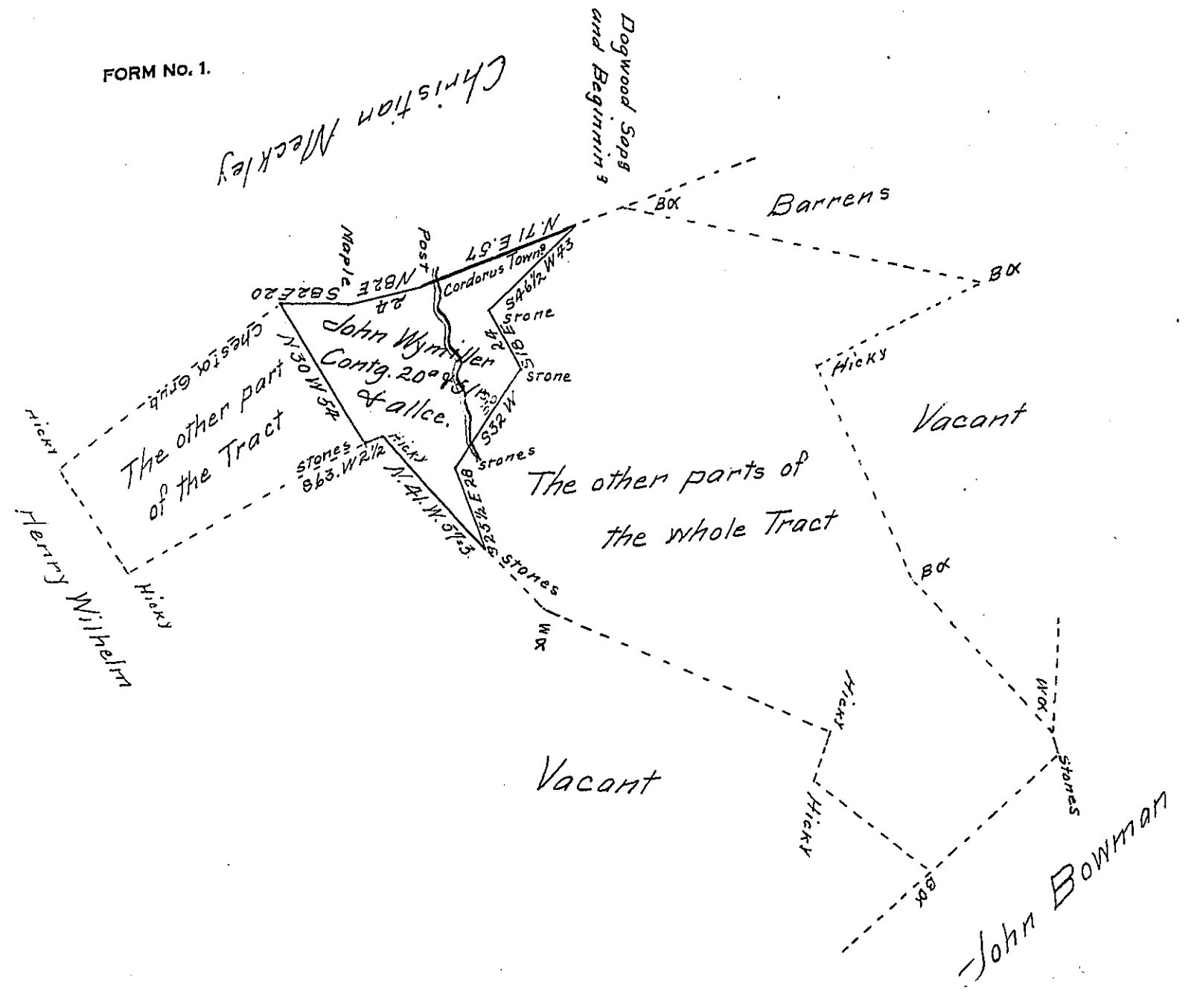

 ing as above set forth 20^{as} & 51 Perches & Allowance Being part of a
 larger tract of 189^{as} & 60 Ps & Allowance, which was Originally Survey-
 ed by William Matthews late D.S. on the 27th of the 8th Mo^o 1768. In
 pursuance of a Warrant for 100^{as} granted to John Wynn Miller
 bearing date the 25th day of May 1749. - Resurveyed & divided off
 from the said larger tract of Land the 7th day of May Anno
 Domini 1800. And now at the request of the present owner
 Jacob Bricker I am desired to make Return of the Draught,
 as calculated examined and found to be correct the 4th day
 of Febr. A. D. 1814. -
