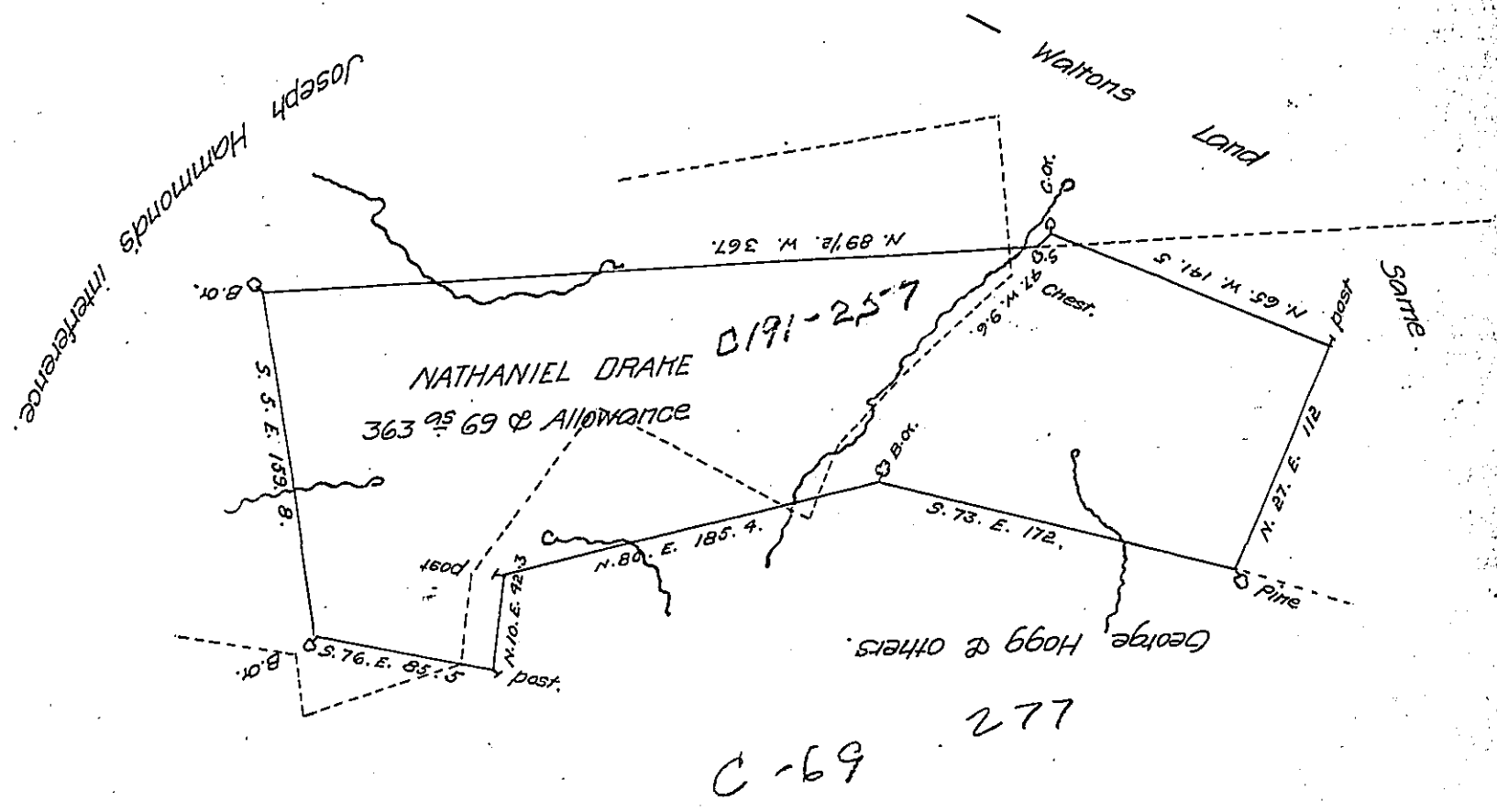


N. 89 1/2 W. is the County Line, between North & Lycoming

I should have thought it Improper to have Interferd with the survey made for Hammond & Kelly but Drake claims an Improvement Right Several years prior to that on which Hammond & Kelly wt was Isued and therfor ought to have his warrant file^d Drake it Appears had not marked any bounds to which he Claimed.
