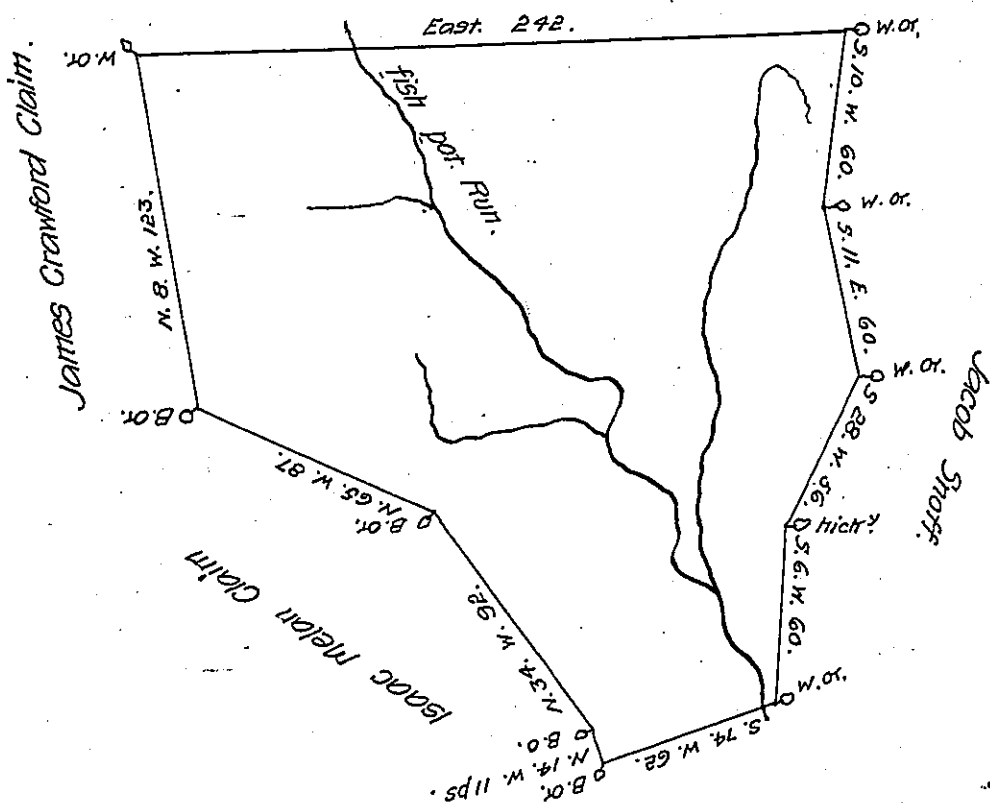


Thomas Cooper Claim

The above is a draught of survey made August 6th 1785. On a Certificate granted (by the Commissioners) in the name of Thomas Bishop Dated December 14th 1779. Called Bishops flats Containing 255 Acres & 138 Perches And is situate in Washington County. A true Copy Viz.; We the Commissioners appointed for adjusting the Claims to unpatented lands in the Counties of Monongalia, Yonogania & Ohio; do hereby Certify that Thomas Bishop is entitled to four hundred Acres of land in the County of Monongalia on Crawfords Run to include his Settlement made in the year of Our Lord One thousand seven hundred and Seventy four. Given under our hands at Redstone for the fourteenth day of December 1779 in the fourth year of the Commonwealth.
