This Warrant is said to be located on ground covered by another warrant of an older date in the name of Robert Miller with which some of the lines appear to agree, but as much doubt exists as to whether the Robert Miller Survey is located on the ground specified by the Warrant or not, and whether the Miller Warrant and Survey are, ^{executed} according to law or not are questions to be decided ~~here~~ consequently the parties urge a return of the Survey in order to have it tested.
