Situate on the Laurel Branch of Stone Creek, containing one hundred and sixty one acres and 130 perches, and allowance of 6 percent for roads, surveyed the 9<sup>th</sup> day December, 1794, in pursuance of a Warrant for 150 acres dated the 15<sup>th</sup> day of January, A.D. 1794.
