



Situate in the Little Juniatta River at the Head of Sharrers (Now Dorseys Mill Race & about one Quarter of a Mile below Miners Narrows in West Township, Huntingdon County. Containing Six Acres 78 perches strick measure. Surveyed the 22<sup>nd</sup> day of April, 1836. In pursuance of a Warrant granted to Jonathan H. Dorsey, for himself, in trust for the other heirs of Greenberry Dorsey, Decs<sup>d</sup>. Dated the 17<sup>th</sup> day of Feb<sup>y</sup> A.D. 1836.
