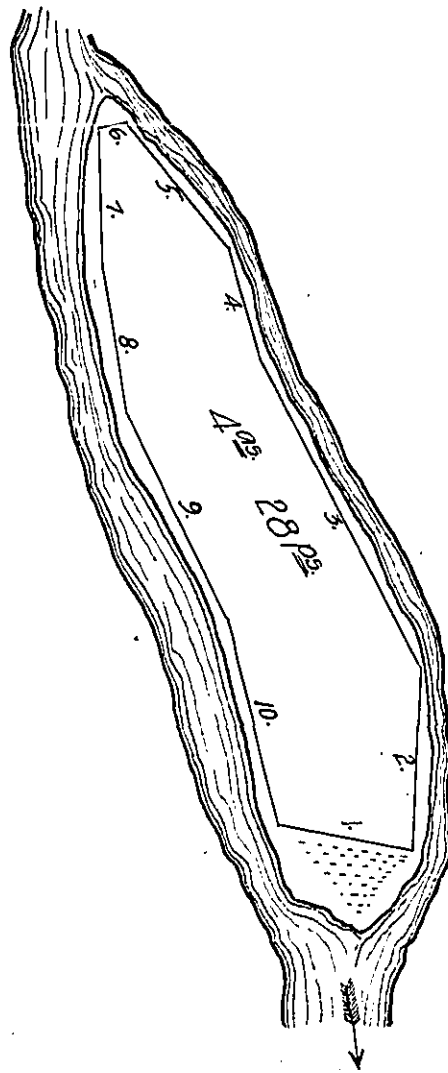

Containing four acres & twenty eight perches. Surveyed for John Hackney on his Warrent granted him dated 5th Day of May A.D. 1828. July 3^d 1828.
