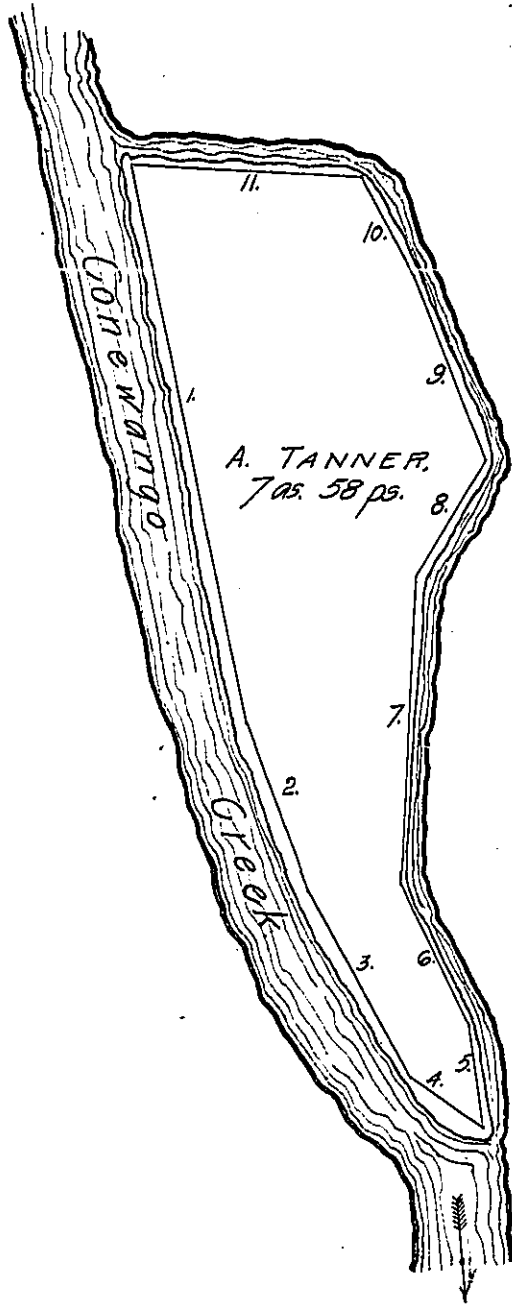

Draft of an Island in the Conewango Creek, Conewango Township, near the East Shore and opposite where David Jackson now lives and the second below one applied for by A. Tanner, opposite an Island Warrented to Joseph Gray, decd, and about three fourths of a mile from the mouth of Conewango Creek. Containing seven acres fifty eight perches & all. Surveyed for Arch<sup>d</sup> Tanner on his Warrent granted him 5<sup>th</sup> May, A.D. 1828, for seven acres fifty eight perches.
