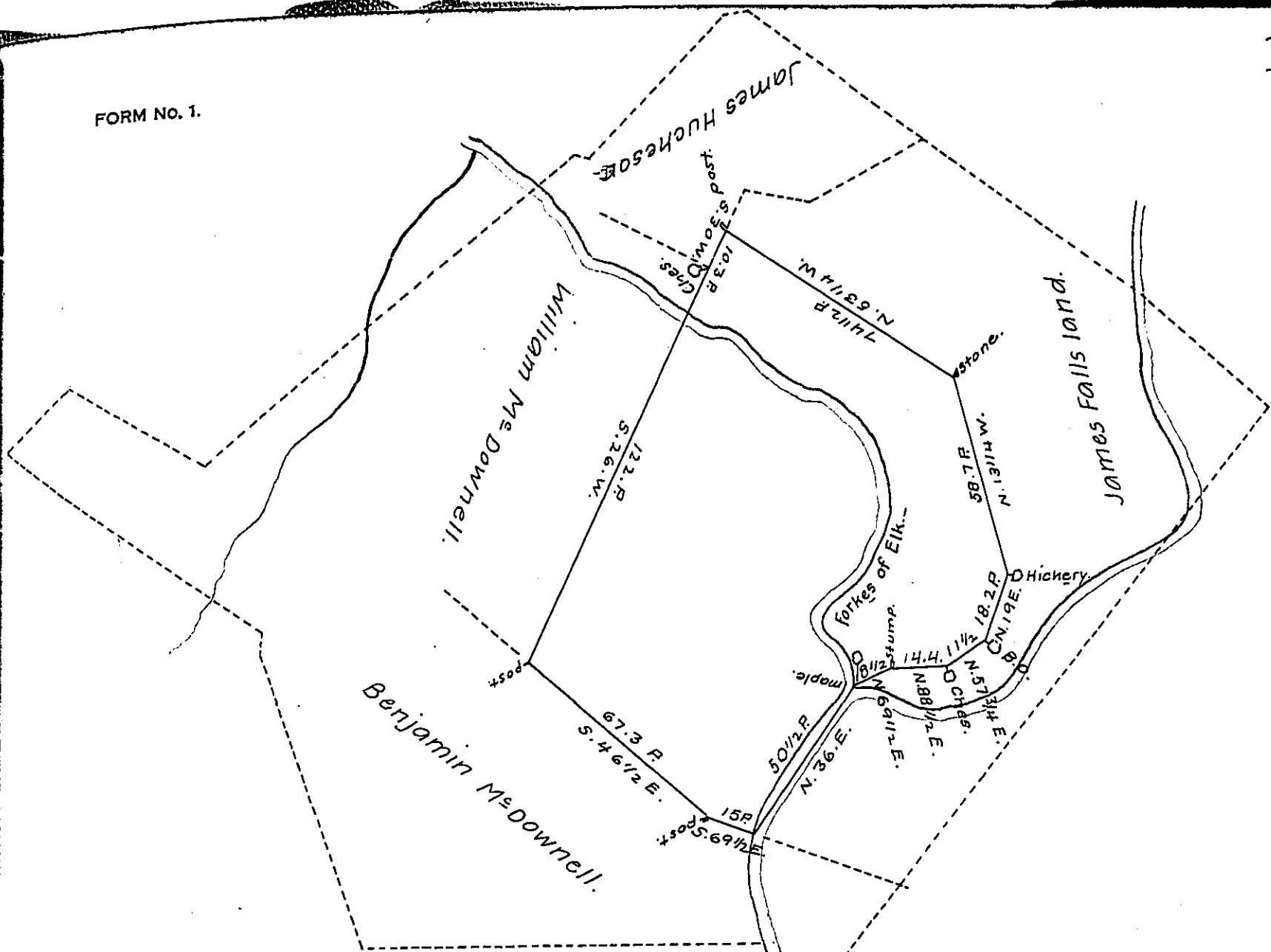


FORM NO. 1.



The above Draught represent a tract of Land situate in East Nottingham Township Chester County containing 75^{as.} & allowance of six per cent. &c. Being a part of a Tract of Land which was Resurveyed for Moses Ross the 19th 12mo. 1755 including a Tract formerly Surveyed and Returned for John Crawford which was vacated and the right vested in Moses Ross the whole contains 308^{as.} & Allowance of Six per Cent. &c. 100^{as.} whereof was Surveyed for Gilbert Buchanan by warrant of the 2nd of May 1753 the other 208^{as.} Resurveyed for Moses Ross aforesaid by Warrant of the 13th of August 1755 the whole directed by him & his relation the said Gilbert to be Returned in one Draught.
