Beginning at a post in the east line of warrant No. 2. thence by the south line of warrants No. 8, 7, and 6 surveyed in 1836 N. 89° 18' E 508.6 rods to a Beech the south east corner of warrant No. 6. thence by the District Line No 5, south 20.7 rods to a Beech the northeast corner of warrant No. 5572. Thence by north line of warrant 5572 surveyed in 1795, west 508.6 rods to a post. Thence by line of warrant No. 2, north 14.6 rods to the place of beginning.
