



The Draught of a tract of Land situate in Walker Township Centre County Con-  
taining one hundred and six Acres and allowance of six per Cent & c<sup>o</sup>. Surveyed the 28<sup>th</sup>  
day of March 1814, in pursuance of a warrant granted to John Lamb dated the 1<sup>st</sup> day of  
February 1814.

The improvement on the above described tract of land at the time of making  
the survey Consisted of a small Cabbin house, and about three acres of Cleared  
land, and a family residing thereon at that time said to be first improved in May 1801.
