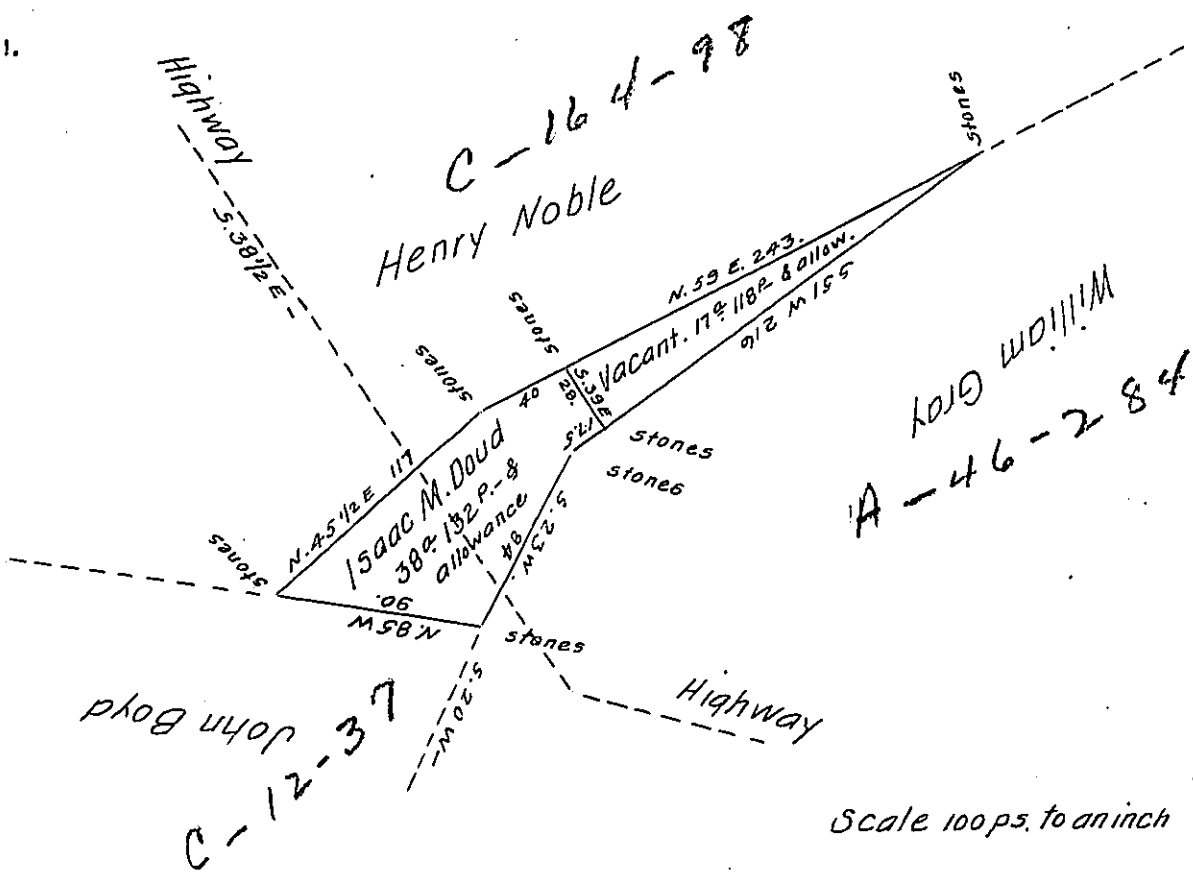

Containing Thirty Eight Acres and one hundred and thirty two perches, besides the usual allowance of Six per cent for Roads &c. With an improvement Since December 1<sup>st</sup> 1822.
