



A Draught of a Tract of land Situate on the East branch of the Tunkhannock Creek, in the Township of Lenox, Susquehanna County, adjoining lands granted to Elizabeth Harris on the South East, Daniel Tallman on the South West, W^m Gray on the North West, and land of the Said John Doud on the North East.

Containing Thirty three Acres and one hundred and eight perches, besides the usual allowance of Six per cent for Roads &c.

With an improvement Since 1806. Surveyed November 26th 1838 - for John Doud in pursuance of a Warrant Dated the 15th day of November 1838.
