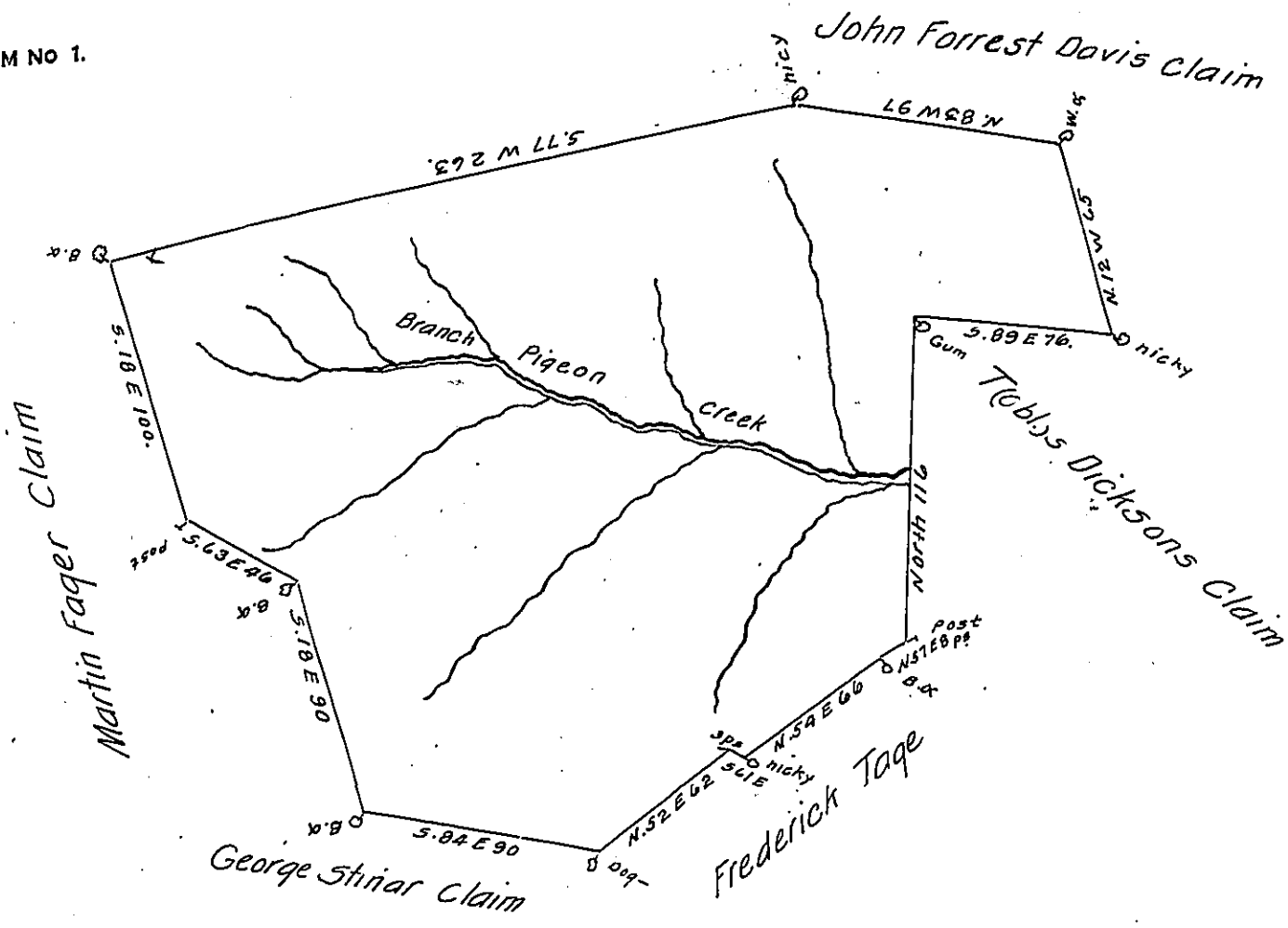

We The Commisioners for Adjusting Claims to Unpatented lands in The County's of Monungahela, Yo hoganian & Ohio do hereby Certify That Thomas Ritchardson is Entitled to four hundred Acres of land in the County of Monungahela on Pigeon Creek - To Include his Settlement made in the Year of Our Lord one Thousand Seven hundred & Seventy four - Also A Right in preerobltion for one Thousand Acres Adjoining Thereto.

Give Under our hands At Redstone Old fort the fourteenth Day of December 1779 - in the fourth Year of the Commonwealth.
