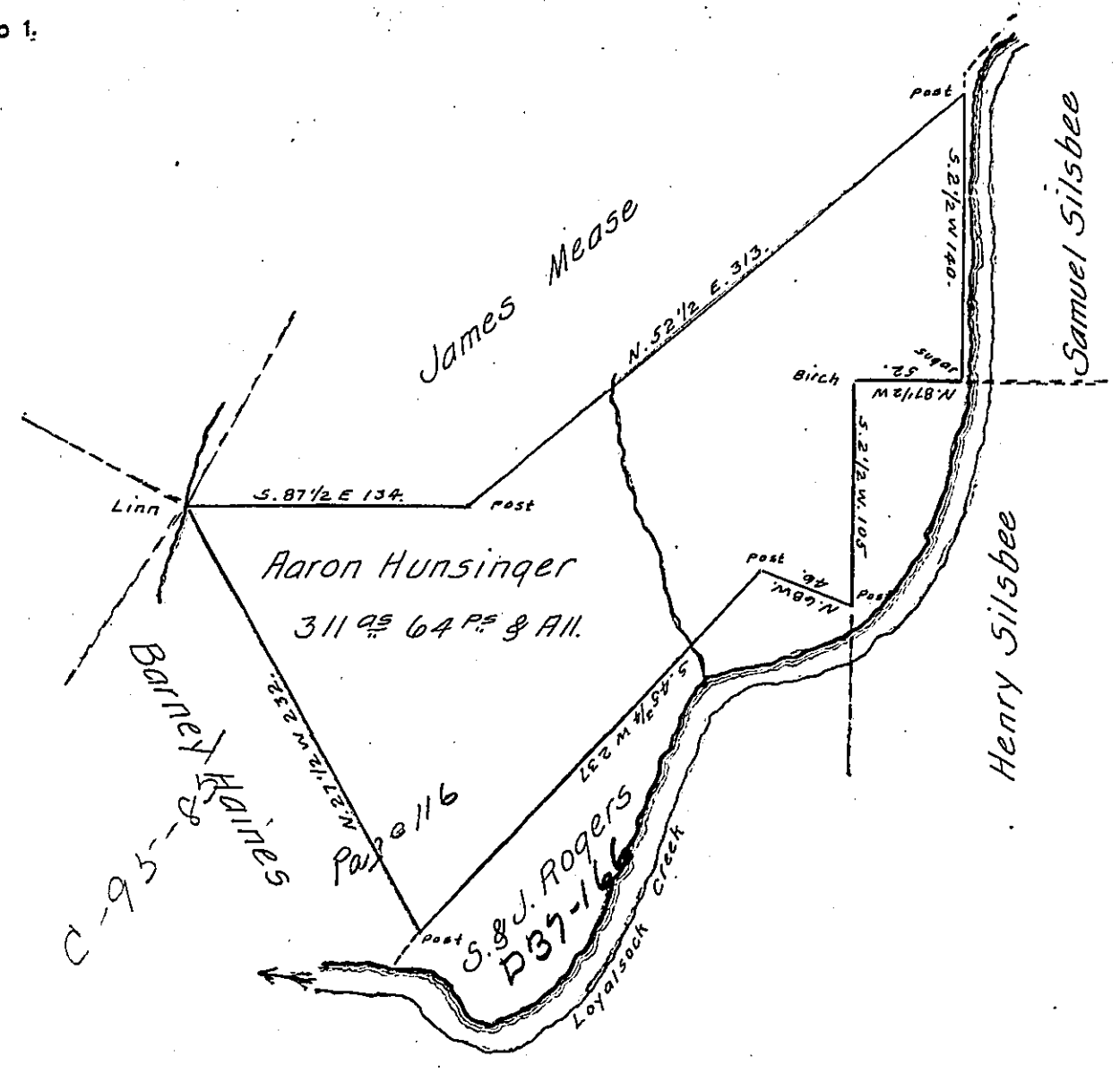


FORM NO 1.



By Virtue of a Warrant granted to Aaron Hunsinger dated Novr. 14<sup>th</sup> 1862  
 Surveyed Novr. 5<sup>th</sup> 1867 adjoining lands of William Campbell on the East  
 who owned at the time of the issuing of the Warrant a part of the Henry Sils-  
 bee tract. Albert Bryan on the South who owned a part of the S. & J. Rogers  
 tract, Timothy Lancaster on the West who owned the Barney Hanes tract  
 and — Elliott on the North who owned a part of the James Mease tract.  
 Containing three hundred and eleven acres. Sixty four perches with the  
 usual allowance of Six per Cent. for roads &c.  
 Situate in Elkland Township County of Sullivan.
