We the Commissioners for Adjusting Claims to unpatented Lands on the Counties of Monongalia, Yohgania and Ohio. do Certify that Daniel Raerdon is intitled to four hundred Acres of land in Yohgania County. on the Waters of Raccoon Creek to include his Settlement made in the year one Thousand Seven hundred & Seventy four. also a Right in preemption to one Thousand Acres Ajoining thereto. given under Our hands at Coxe's Fort the tenth day of February 1780. in the fourth year of the Common Wealth.
