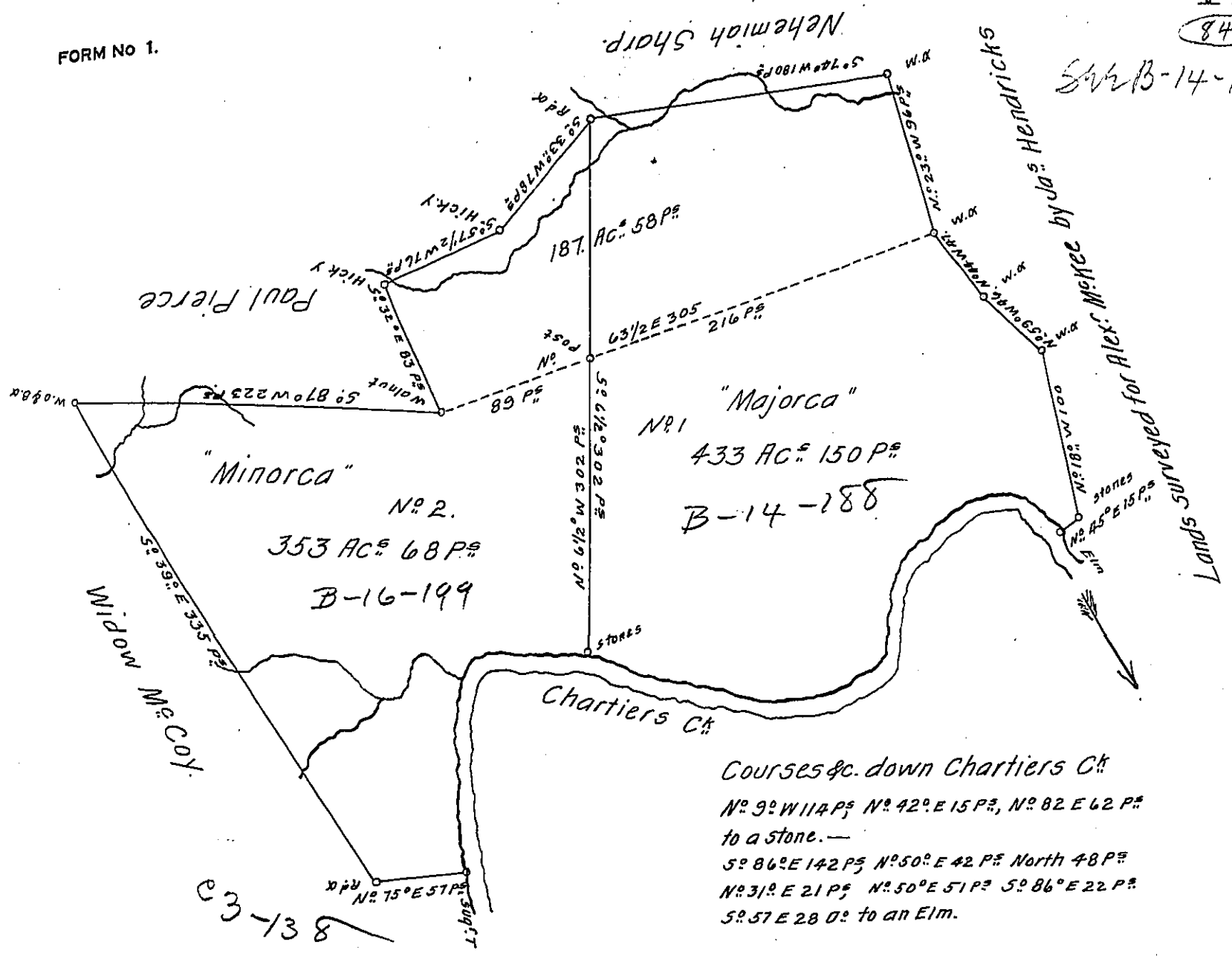

No. 1. contain<sup>g</sup> 433 Ac. 150 P. on a Warr.<sup>t</sup> granted to Colo. Geo. Morgan for 400 Ac. dated May the 2<sup>d</sup> 1785. No. 2. on an Order granted to Robert Bailey for 300 Ac. dated Ap<sup>l</sup>. ye 3<sup>d</sup> 1769. No. 1797. No. 1. was also surveyed on an order granted to Mary Barclay for 300 Ac. dated Ap<sup>l</sup>. ye 3<sup>d</sup> 1769. No. 1625. There are different Claimants to the two Orders dated Ap<sup>l</sup>. ye 3<sup>d</sup> 1769. (a. M. Peary and Doct. Jn. Morgan) each of whom have had the Lands surveyed for themselves. we Return the whole together that the Board of Property may with more ease determine on the Matter. should they decide in favour of the two 300 Ac. Orders. No. 1 contains within the dotted Line. 304 Ac. 150 P. & Allow<sup>ce</sup>. And No. 2. 295 Ac. 10 P. and Allow<sup>ce</sup>. the Ball<sup>ce</sup> 187 Ac. 58 P.
