



The above is a Draught of a Survey made Feb. 4th 1833. in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Samuel Madden for 8 Acres of land. Dated Jan. 2^d 1833. Containing Seven Acres and eight^h perches and Allowance of Six per Cent for highways. Situate in Morris Township. Washington Co. on the head waters of Ten mile Creek — There had formerly been an actual Settlement on the ground but is now abandoned. the foundation of the old Cabin is now visible.
