



The above is a Draught of a Survey made August 26th 1829. in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Barnard Jackman Dated June 29th 1829. for ten Acres of Land. but Contains ninety three Acres & 52 perches and Allowance of six pr. Cent for highways. Situate in Pike Run Township W. County. Note. Seth Buffington Esq^r. bought the above land from David Redick Esq^r. agent for the heirs of Biddle. and is now. and has been for many years. an actual Settler on the same. although he has no Office title. Note. also that the above does not Join Springer as called for in the Warrant. John Jackman comes in between.
