



In pursuance of a Law passed 11<sup>th</sup> April 1799 for the Selling Certain Reserved tracts of land therein named, the Instructions of the late Governor dated 14<sup>th</sup> May 1799 and the Order of the Surveyor General thereupon dated 18<sup>th</sup> May 1799 Surveyed the 18<sup>th</sup> day of Sept<sup>r</sup> 1799 the above described tract of land being Lot No 3. of the Reserved tract Called Warren in (now) Warren County. Containing One hundred & forty nine Acres & One hundred & thirty six perches strict measure.
