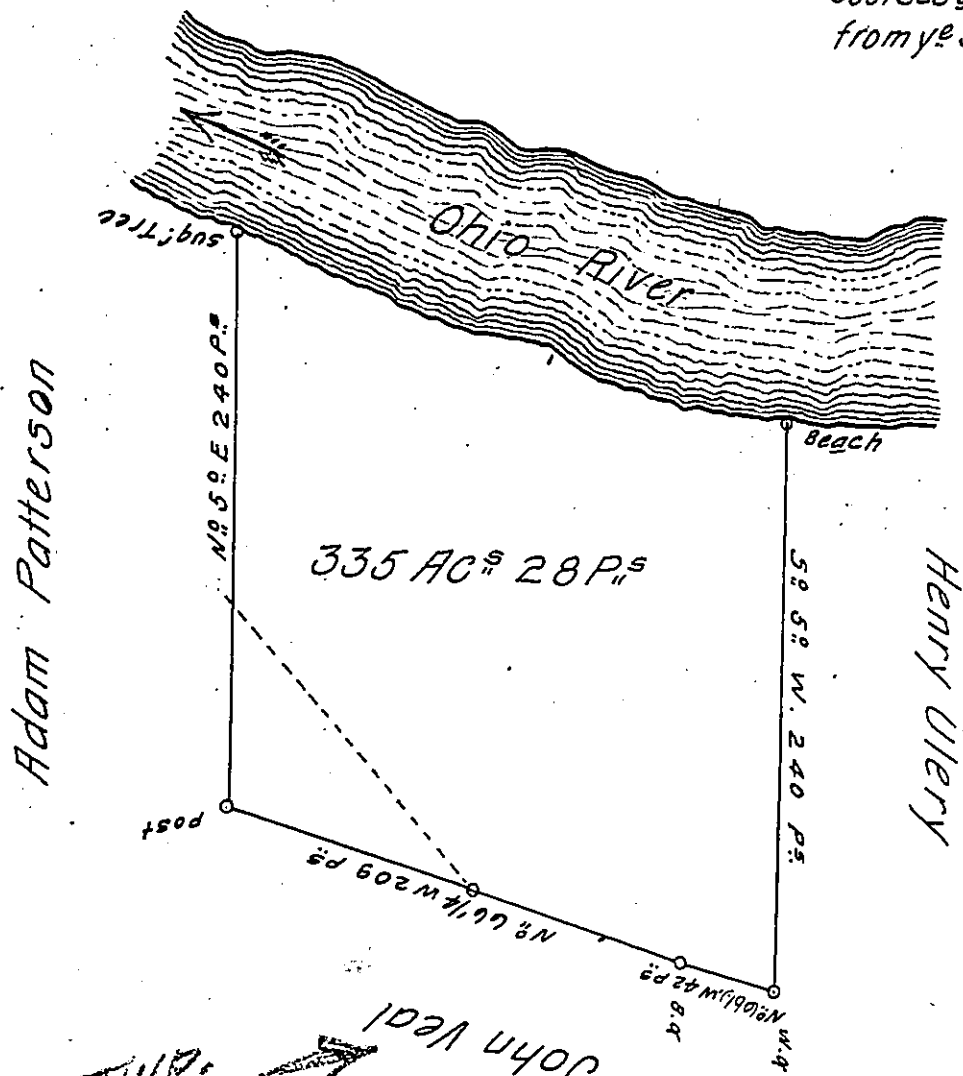

A Draught of a Survey called Montours Bottom, situate on the south Bank of the Ohio river in Allegheny County, containing 335 Ac. 28 P. and the usual allowance for Roads &c. executed March the 27<sup>th</sup> 1800 (in Pursuance of a Special order from under the hand & Seal of the Surv<sup>r</sup> Gen<sup>l</sup> of Pennsylv<sup>a</sup> dated the 10<sup>th</sup> day of Feb. y. 1800) ~~made~~ on an application & Warrant for 350 Ac. in the name of John Vander in Sen dated Sept<sup>r</sup> 27<sup>th</sup> 1786. The above tract except the triangular space (which is claimed by John Veal) is surveyed and patented on an Office right. (I am told in the name of Tho<sup>s</sup> McKee) but I did not survey it & have no record in my Office. The above includes Mich<sup>l</sup> Thork's Imp<sup>t</sup> which Edw<sup>d</sup> Ward someway claimed
