



In pursuance of a Law passed the 11<sup>th</sup> day of April 1799. for Selling certain Reserved Tracts therein named. the Instructions of the Late Governor dated the 14<sup>th</sup> day of May 1799. and the Order of the Surveyor General. dated the 18<sup>th</sup> day of May 1799 Surveyed the 1<sup>st</sup> day of November 1799. the above described Tract of Land being— N° 3 of the Reserved Tract called Waterford (now) Erie County Containing one hundred acres and eight perches strict Measure.
