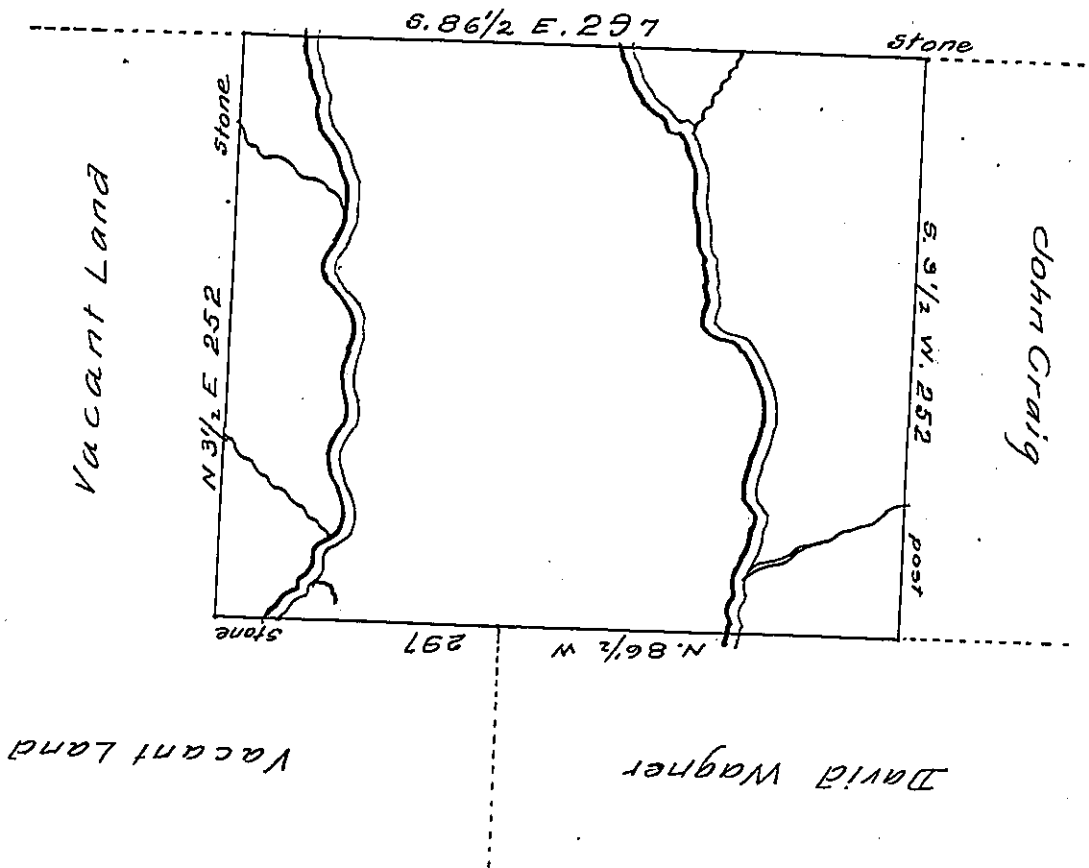


State of New York



By Virtue of a Warrant dated the 1<sup>st</sup> July 1784 Surveyed the 18<sup>th</sup> October 1785 to Robert Traill the above described tract of Land situate on the Dividing ridge between Delaware and Susquehanna in Northampton County Containing Four hundred and forty one acres forty seven perches and the allowance of six p cent &c<sup>o</sup>.
