Resurveyed unto Christopher Johnston on the 17<sup>th</sup> day of June 1813 by virtue of his order of Survey dated the 25<sup>th</sup> May 1813 in Right of George Books - That part within the Colored lines you will find was Surveyed & returned on Warrant dated the 2<sup>d</sup> February 1792 & Return<sup>d</sup> for Matthew Irwine The present Survey you will find is agreeable to the former Survey made for George Books - but containd more than could be Return<sup>d</sup> & had been Reduced by Gen<sup>l</sup> Wm Montgomery when he made the Return
