



Situated in Tyrone Township Adams County. This tract was surveyed in pursuance of two separate warrants. The first is a part of a larger tract said to contain 313 ac & all, which was surveyed in pursuance of a Warrant from the Hon. the Proprietor of the Province of Pennsylvania granted to Findley McGrew (Sen) dated the 20<sup>th</sup> of June A. D. 1737. And the 2<sup>nd</sup> market A. was surveyed by M. McClain D.S. the 15<sup>th</sup> day of Nov. 1798. In pursuance of a Warrant for 40 ac Granted to Findley McGrew dated the 14<sup>th</sup> March 1794. And the whole was Resurveyed in one entire tract at the request of Joseph Trastle the present Owner in Order that a Patent may be issued for the same on Jan. 23<sup>rd</sup> 1851.
