



A draught of a piece of land situate in Washington Township formerly Warrington Township in the County of York containing as above set forth 107^a 37 Pcs and Allowances. Surveyed on the 19th day of November A.D. 1832 in Pursuance of a Warrant granted to Jonathan Marsh for 15^a dated the 26th day of October A.D. 1769. The above land is now owned where the letter A stands by Peter Vale containing 63^a 3 per^s and Allowances. The part where the letter B stands is owned by Samuel Cook containing 44^a 34 pcs. and allowances. In right of a Warrant granted to John Marsh dated the 27th day of January A.D. 1802 &c.
