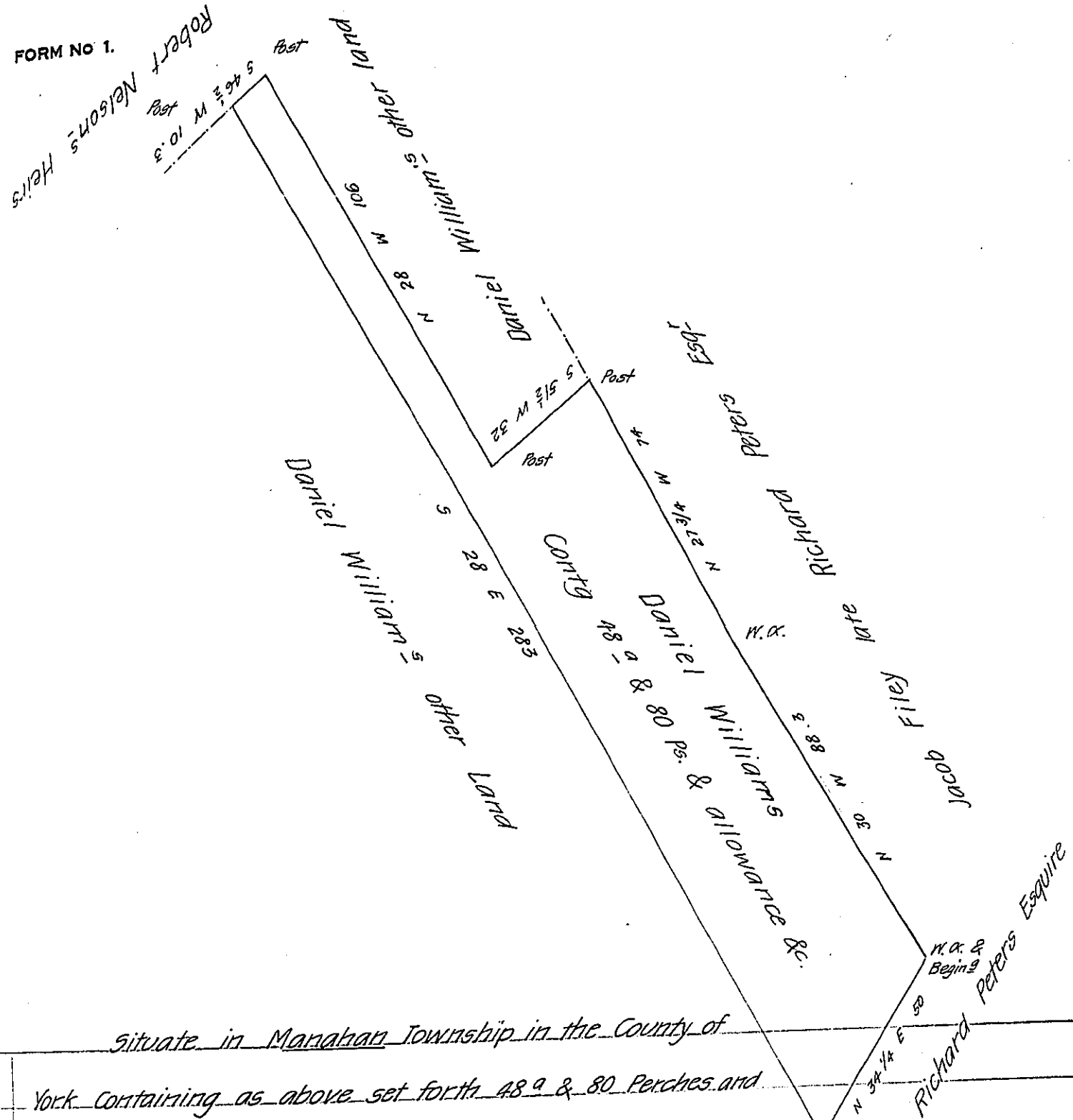

Situate in Manahan Township in the County of York containing as above set forth 48<sup>a</sup> & 80 Perches and the Usual Allowance of Six per Cent for Roads &c. Surveyed on the 22<sup>d</sup> day of November A.D. 1814 In Pursuance of a Warrant for 50<sup>a</sup> granted to Daniel Williams bearing date the 2<sup>d</sup> day of February A.D. 1804 Resurveyed on the 23<sup>d</sup> day of August 1815 agreeably to the decision of the Honourable Board of Property dated the 7<sup>th</sup> day of June A.D. 1815 And now at the request of the owner Daniel Williams the above has been returned agreeably to the judgment and determination of arbitrators under a Rule of Court on a trial of an Ejectment Daniel Williams vs. David Ayres dated September 10<sup>th</sup> A.D. 1816
