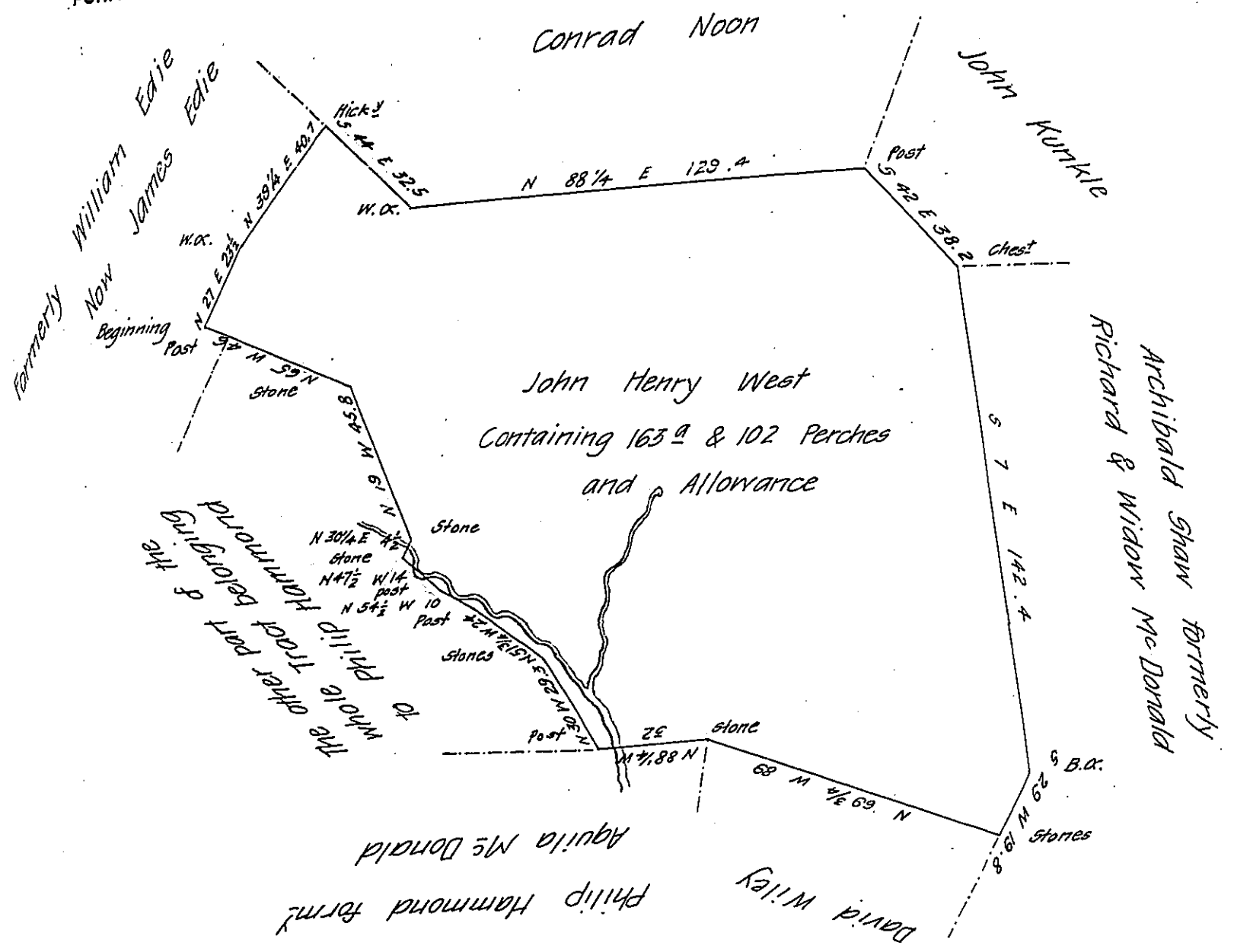

Situate in Hopedell Township in the County of York containing as above set forth 163<sup>a</sup> & 102 Perches and allowance Being part of a larger tract of land which was originally surveyed on the 25<sup>th</sup> day of April Anno-Domini 1797 by John Forsyth late D.S. In pursuance of a Warrant for 200<sup>a</sup> granted to John Henry West bearing date the 10<sup>th</sup> day of November A.D<sup>o</sup> 1787 Resurveyed and divided off from the said larger tract of land the 27<sup>th</sup> day of October Anno-Domini 1808 - at the request of Jacob Larius the present owner who desired us to make
