



In pursuance of an Act of General Assembly of the state of Pennsylvania passed the 24<sup>th</sup> day of February 1785 entitled an Act for directing the mode of distributing the donation lands promised the troops of this Commonwealth & by order of the Surveyor General with the approbation of the Honourable the Executive Council. I have surveyed on the 13<sup>th</sup> day of December 1785 the above described tract of two hundred acres of land & the allow<sup>e</sup> of six 7/15 cent. for roads, No CCCCXX situate in district No 2 on the west side of Allegany river in Westmoreland County.
