



In pursuance of an obl. of General Assembly of the state of Pennsylvania passed the 2^o obl. day of February 1785 obl. titled an Act for directing the mode of distributing the donation lands promised the troops of this Commonwealth & by order of the Surveyor General with the approbation of the Honourable the Executive Council. I have surveyed on the eight-day of November 1785 the above described tract of five hundred acres of land & the allowance of six $\frac{1}{2}$ cent. for roads &c. No XXXI situate in district No 2 on the west side of Allegany river in Westmoreland — County.
