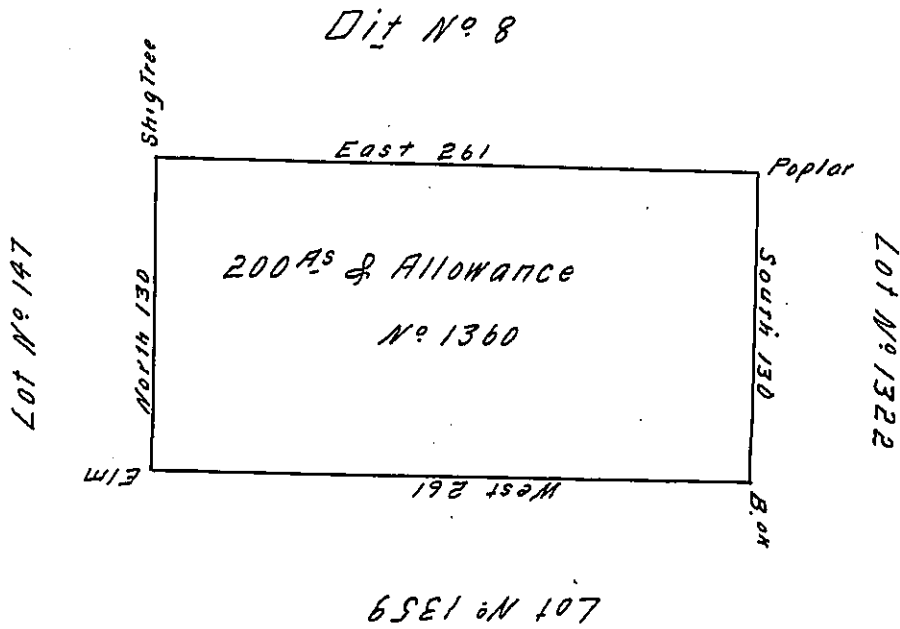

for Road & No MCCCLX situate in District No 7 on the West side
of the Allegeny River in the County of Westmorland.
