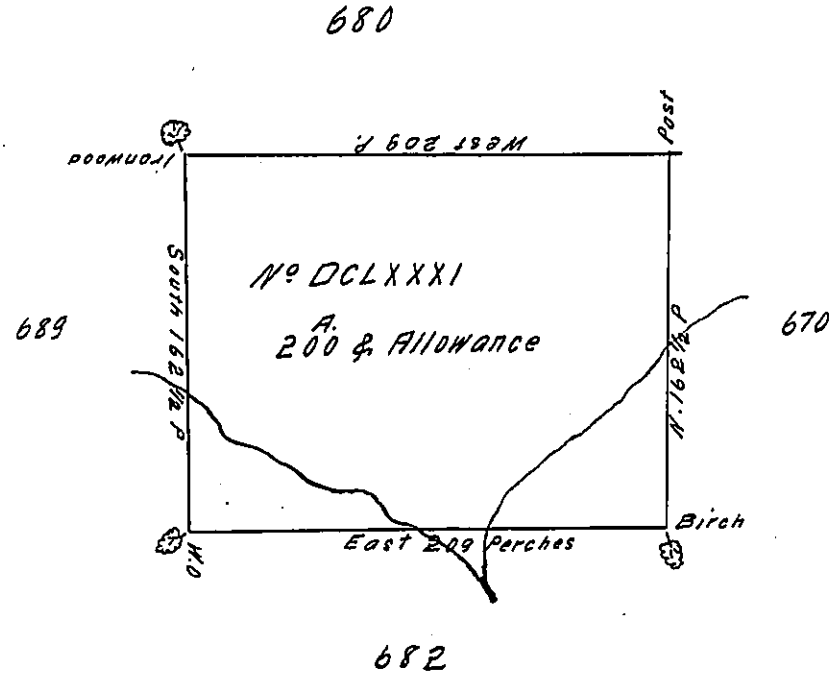

In Pursuance of an Act of General Assembly  
of the State of Pennsylvania passed the 24<sup>th</sup> Day of February  
1785 entitled "an Act for directing the Mode of distributing the  
Donation Lands promised the Troops of this Common-wealth" and  
by Order of the Surveyor General with the Approbation of the  
Hon<sup>ble</sup> the Executive Council, I have Survey'd on the 24<sup>th</sup> d<sup>y</sup> of  
July 1785 the above described tract of two hundred Acres of  
Land & Allow<sup>ce</sup> of six P.Ct for Roads &c Nº DCLXXXI situate in Dist-  
rict Nº 4 on the west side of the Allegany River in the County  
of Westmoreland.
