of the State of Pennsylvania, passed the twenty fourth Day of Fe-
bruary, one thousand seven hundred and eighty five, entitled an
Act "for directing the Mode of distributing the Donation Lands, prom-
ised to the Troops by this Commonwealth," and by Order of the SUR-
veyor General, with the approbation of the Honorable the Executive
Council, I have surveyed on the first Day of October one thousand
seven hundred and eighty five, the above described Tract of two hund-
red Acres of Land, and Allowance for Roads, &c. No. 475 situate in
District No. III, on the West side of the Alligany River, in the County
of Westmoreland.
