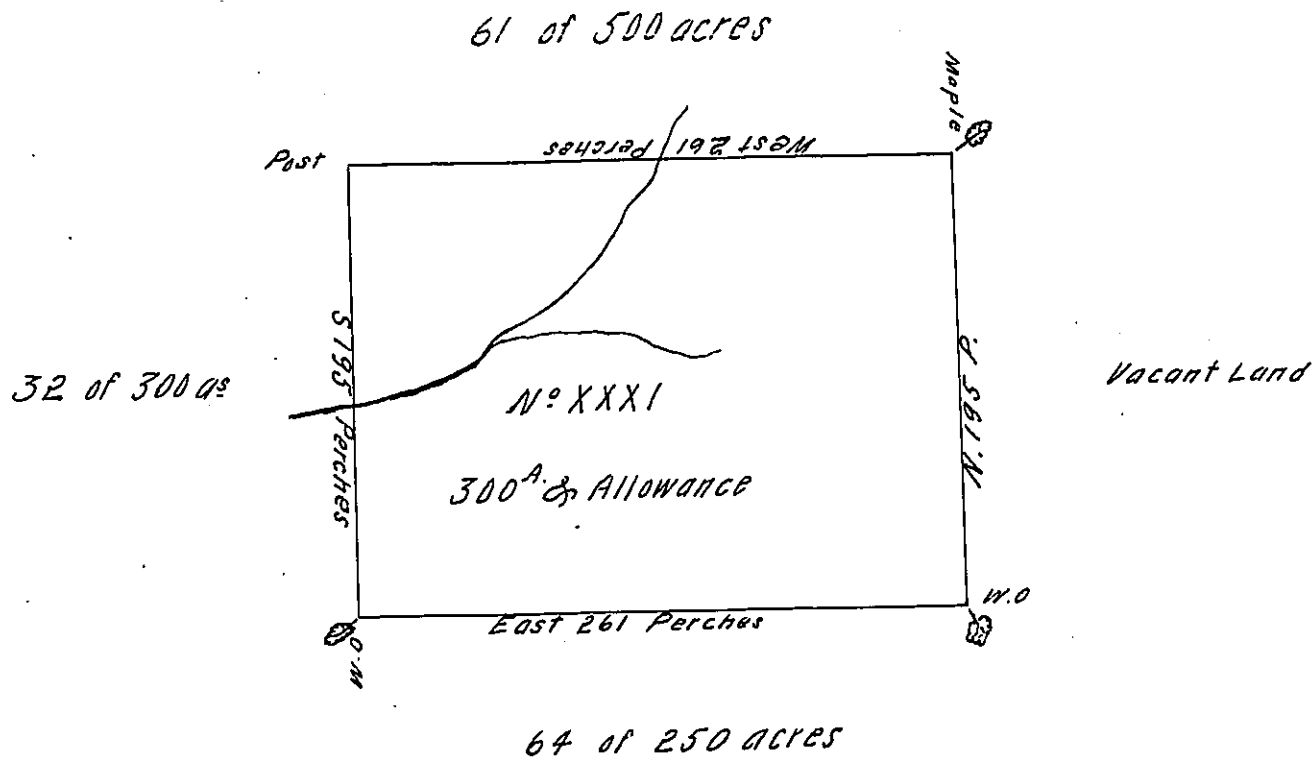

In Pursuance of an Act of General Assembly of the State of Pennsylvania Passed the 24th day of Feb^r 1785 entitled "an Act for directing the Mode of distributing the Donation Lands Promised the Troops of this Commonwealth" and by order of the Surveyer General, with the Approbation of the Hon^{le} the Executive Council, I have surveyed on the 16th July 1785 the above discribed Tract of Three Hundred acres of Land & Allow^e of Six P. Ct for roads &c. Nº XXXI. situate in District Nº 4. on the west side of the Allegany river in the County of Westmoreland.
