the State of Pennsylvania passed the 24th Day of February 1785 entitled
"an Act for directing the Mode of distributing the Donation Lands promised
to the Troops of this Commonwealth" and by order of the Surveyor General
with the approbation of the Hon^{ble} the Executive Council I have Survey'd
on the 29th day of August 1785 the above described tract of two hundred
Acres of Land & Allow^{ce} of six Pct for Roads &c. No. DCCLXXXVII situate
in District N^o 4 on the west side of the Allegany - in the County of
Westmoreland.
