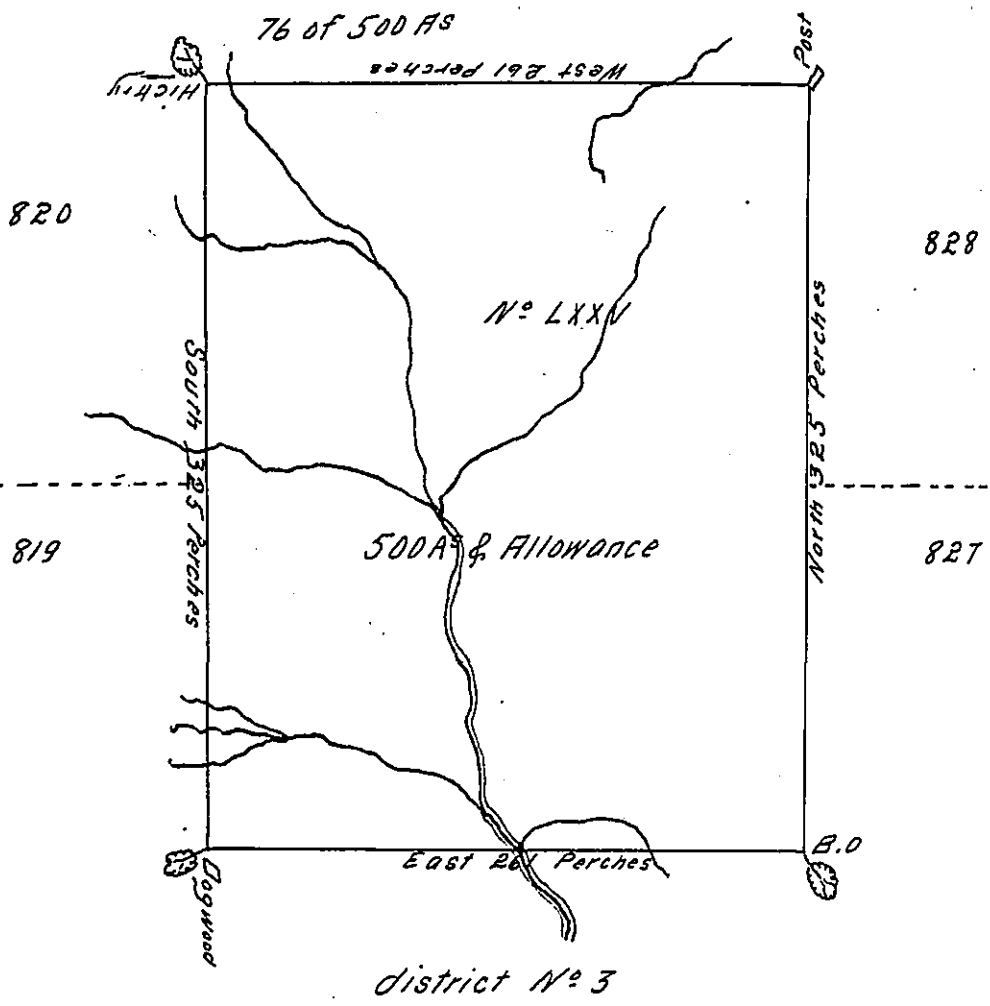

In Pursuance of an Act of General Assembly of the State of Penn^a passed the 24th day of February 1785 entitled "an Act for directing the Mode of distributing the Donation Lands promised the Troops of this Common-wealth" and by order of the Surveyer General, with the Approbation of the Hon^l the Executive Council, I have surveyed on the 12th day of Sept 1785 the above described Tract of five Hundred acres of Land & Allowance of six Pct for Roads &c. N° LXXV situate in District N° 4 on the West side of the Allegany river in the County of Westmore land.
